<b>Executive Summary</b> This report gives an overview of primary care workforce and population demographics compared to England.  The initial impact of the Covid19 pandemic saw GP appointments fall by 24% in the first three months of 2020/21 compared with last year. This is comparable with national rates. Face-to-Face appointments have fell by 47% and Non Face-to-Face appointments increased by 130%.  The coronavirus pandemic has had a significant impact on secondary care activity. The first 2 months of 2020/21 have seen a sharp drop in activity in most services.  The report is presented to PCCC for the first time as a NY CC report and includes data available at NY level. It is recognised that the report needs to include additional quality data and other primary indicators including Learning Disability (LD) and Serious Mental Illness (SMI) health check performance as well as cervical screening and immunisation rates. In addition flu vaccination rates will be included as this data becomes available.
