

Suspected Sarcoma

Soft Tissue Sarcoma

Bone

Consider imaging with unexplained lump with one of the following:

- >3cm *
- Appears clinically deep to superficial fascia
- More firm than subcutaneous fat
- Enlarging
- Painful

If X-ray suggests the possibility of bone sarcoma

Urgent Ultrasound (In 2 weeks)

Consider

Features suggestive of sarcoma / equivocal imaging but persistent clinical concerns/
Lipoma >7cm

2WW Referral

Simultaneous MRI referral (can often be rearranged same day as ultrasound by radiologist)

*2ww timeframe referral for >3cm lesion present for a long period without other concerning features is unlikely to be appropriate.

Decision for biopsy vs excision best made via sarcoma MDT
