PARACETAMOL

In North Yorkshire**, almost £725,000 was spent last year on prescribing paracetamol - this could be used for 2,685 emergency ambulance trips.

DID YOU KNOW?

The cost to the NHS for prescribing paracetamol every year is £80 million.

On prescription the cost of 32 tablets is around three times more than for a patient to buy locally.
