## What happens next?

Equipment loaned to a service user that is no longer needed is returned by user/family to the drop off locations. At each of the drop off locations there is a large blue amnesty bin. The returned items will be placed inside these bins for storage.

Medequip send a technician with an empty van to empty the amnesty bin and return the items to the Medequip depot.

The returned items are assessed for their suitability for recycling. Items that are suitable for recycling will go through the decontamination process.

The recycled item is put back on the Medequip shelf awaiting an order for the next person who requires it's use. Once the amnesty bin is full of

returned items, the amnesty bin coordinator at each location will contact Medequip to request a collection.

Once the items have been cleaned, the repairs team will carry out any repair work required to ensure that the collected items are suitable for reuse within the community.
